Event FAQs

Q: Where should I park for WEDIfest 2023?

A: Guests have many options for parking.

1. Paid parking in gated M&T Bank lot on Washington St. (\$3.00)
2. Paid surface lots around the Market Arcade (ranges between \$5 - \$10)
3. On-street parking, which is free after 5 p.m.

Q: Which entrance should I enter through at the Downtown Bazaar?

A: **This is VERY important! Guests should enter through the Market Arcade Atrium via the Main Street or Washington Street entrances to check-in, then can enter the Bazaar for the event.**

Q: What time is the event?

A: The event runs from 6:30pm until 9:30pm.

Q: What's going on at the event?

A: The Downtown Bazaar is set-up food hall style. Guests can visit each restaurant for sample-size portions of their special event menu. And, don't worry, we'll have plenty of tables and seating for guests to enjoy the cuisine.

Q: What kind of food is being served?

A: In signature Bazaar fashion, the menu consists of authentic Burmese, Ethiopian, Filipino, Thai, and South Sudanese dishes.
